KODAK SUMMER PROMOTIONS

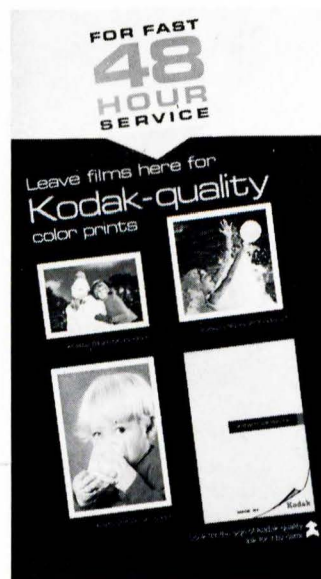


Television

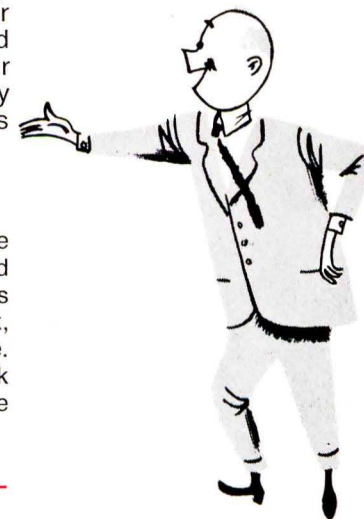
This summer, your customers are looking for Kodak quality photo-finishing. They will expect the Kodak service where they see the Kodak sign.

Holiday Time is Photo-finishing Time

When your regular customers are off on holiday, you naturally remind them to take along plenty of Kodak film. Thus, you are assured of making extra sales of film in the holiday period. But what about photo-finishing?

The dealer who promotes Kodak photo-finishing is the one who makes the big extra profit from the holiday season.

If your customers are going on a short trip, they will probably find it most convenient to save their exposed films until they return home, and hand them in to you for photo-finishing. On longer absences, however, say of two weeks or more, they will probably want to have their films processed as soon as they are exposed.



Color Films

Color films should be processed as soon as possible after exposure. Kodachrome with processing prepaid presents no problems; the customer simply drops his films, suitably addressed, into any convenient mail box, and his transparencies will be awaiting his return home. But how many of your customers realise that, with Kodak Prepaid Processing Mailers, they can have the same service for Kodak Ektachrome and Kodacolor films?

Sell the benefits of Kodak Prepaid Processing Mailers—

1. Film and Finishing paid for at one time.
2. Price advantage of 5 cents per print for Kodacolor.

Black-and-White Films

Many people want to see their pictures while still on holiday. Advertise the fact that you offer Kodak photo-finishing services and when customers bring you their exposed films, offer to sell them a new film, too. Maybe they didn't stock up sufficiently before leaving home!

Active Promotion

Active promotion is the key to increased photo-finishing profit for you, especially if you are in a holiday-making area. Establish your store as the local centre for Kodak photo-finishing by displaying the Kodak transfer prominently, and the showcard with the "48 hour service" crowner. Make sure your local newspaper advertising includes a mention of Kodak photo-finishing services.

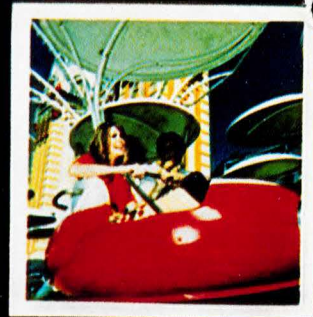
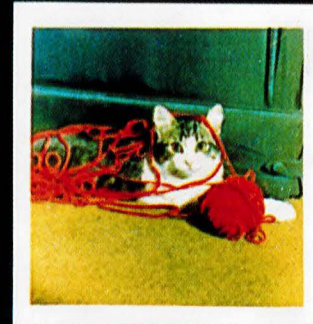
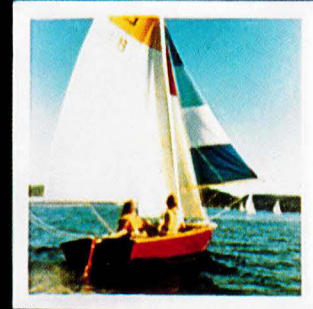

Flashcube and Flashbulb Discounts and Prices

Effective February 1st.

Increased discounts for Kodak Dealers on quantity lots of Flashcubes and Flashbulbs.

Effective March 1st.

Lower retail price for Flashcubes.

1. We are pleased to announce that from February 1st, 1969, Kodak will provide dealers with increased discount on quantity orders of either Sylvania Flashcubes or Philips Flashbulbs. Details are as follows:

Sylvania Flashcubes

Quantity	Discount off Retail Price
Packet — 3	25%
Carton — 36	30%
Shipping Container — 432	33½%

Philips Flashbulbs AG-1B or PF 1B

Quantity	Discount off Retail Price

2. From **March 1st**, 1969, the **retail price** for Sylvania **Flashcubes** marketed by Kodak (Australia) Pty. Ltd. will be reduced to **50 cents** each. The new **dealer price** for Flashcubes will operate from **February 1st**, 1969. In addition, dealers will be able to make more profit by buying in carton lots or shipping containers. There will be no change to the retail price of either AG-1B or PF 1B Flashbulbs.

3. Flash photography has become very popular since the convenient flashcube was introduced. All the latest Kodak cameras are designed to accept flashcubes. Statistics show that people with flashcube cameras take many more pictures than those with older type cameras. There is, therefore, an increasing demand for flashcubes and, now that the retail price is being reduced to 50 cents each (almost the same as flashbulbs), the market is set to leap ahead.

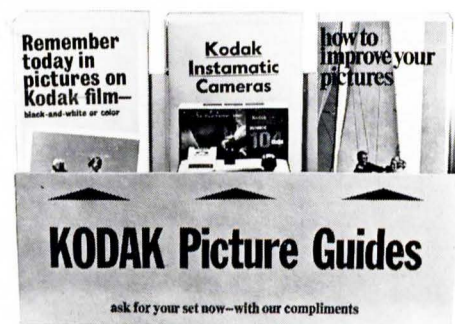

MALLORY BATTERIES for All Modern Products

Kodak is extending the range of Mallory batteries stocked, to include some of the popular sizes for non-photographic use.

In developing their mercury and alkaline batteries, Mallory perfected new methods of generating more power from a dry cell *and new ways of safely locking it in*. Mallory batteries last longer, deliver their power evenly, do not need time to recuperate. They can lie idle for two years and still retain voltage stability. It is because of this stability-plus-safety that Kodak is happy to stock and recommend Mallory batteries for Kodak products.

Look for the Letters

Mallory make two distinct types of battery for photographic applications: Mercury and Alkaline.

Mercury batteries have the prefix PX and are designed for such applications as CdS meters, electric eye systems and electronic shutter controls. There is no adequate substitute for a mercury cell.

Mallory Alkaline batteries have the prefix MN: These batteries have longer life and greater efficiency in flashholders, slide viewers, movie cameras and tape recorder motors.

All Applications

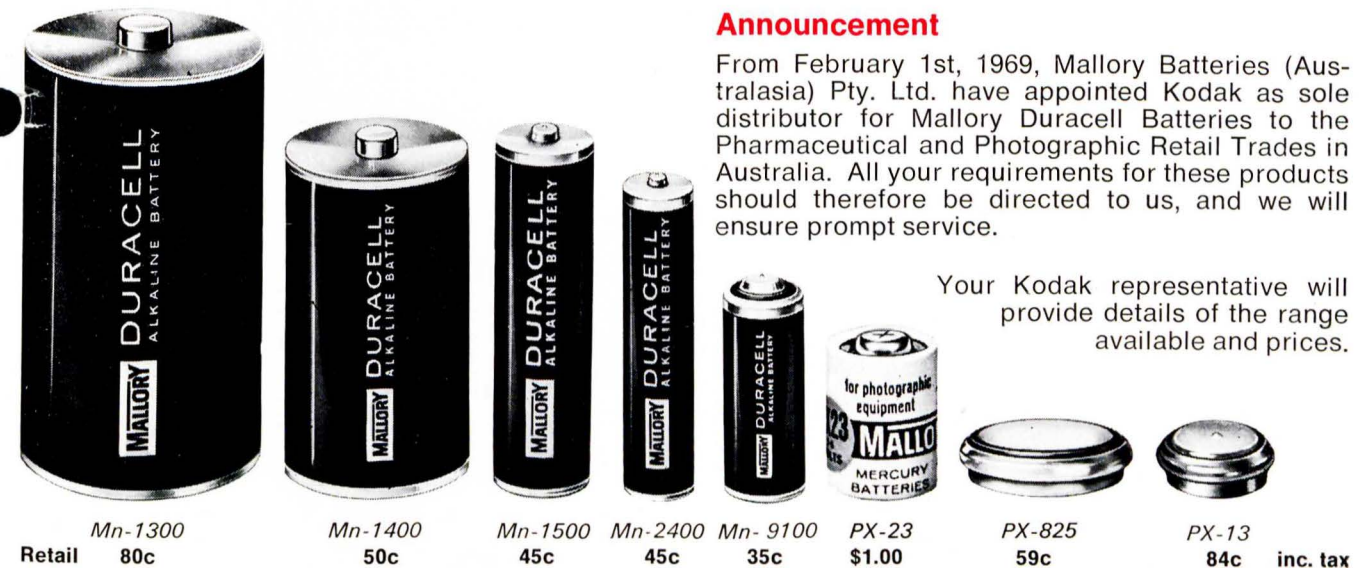
The same benefits of safety, reliability and long life apply to Mallory batteries used in torches, transistor radios, battery powered toys (those Christmas ones must be a bit flat by now!) etc.

Mallory batteries may cost a little more, but the price is justified by longer life. Promote this profitable line. Display Mallory batteries and remind customers frequently to check their batteries. Statistics show that batteries are largely impulse purchases.
