The K5 camera outfit includes camera case, lens cover, garry strap, two AA alkaline batteries and a roll of Kodacolor VR 35mm film.



**K4** An easy to use 35mm camera with built-in electronic flash. Just select the film speed (ISO 100, 200 or 400), then aim and shoot for great results, every time. Covered by a one year warranty. The K4 camera outfit includes camera case, roll of Kodacolor VR 35mm film and two AA alkaline batteries. Sliding lens cover.



**K6** For the more advanced photographer, the K6 includes all the features of the K5 plus automatic built-in electronic flash with fill-in flash switch for back-lit subjects and automatic exposure control. Covered by a one year warranty. The K6 camera outfit includes camera case, lens cover, camera strap, 2 AA alkaline batteries and roll of Kodacolor VR 35mm film.
