FIXER DIRECTIONS MEAN WHAT THEY SAY!

Over the last few months we have received comments that our Acid Fixer with Hardener produces a very milky solution when dissolved. We had a look at various batches and could not at first see any cause for such a complaint. On continuing our investigations, however, we noted that if a volume of water much in excess of the nominated volume was taken on dissolving the powder, a very milky Fixer resulted. It is possible, therefore, that some photographers like to use a more dilute Fixer than the standard product, and possibly dissolve a one gallon tin in a gallon and a half of water. If this is done by taking the gallon and a half of water and adding the powder to it, a milky solution will usually result but if, on the other hand, a can of Fixer is made up to its correct volume first and then diluted, the solution will remain clear. In short, we are pointing out that the directions should be followed precisely.

We mention this finding because it may be at the root of at least some of the comments which Branch personnel have received.

DISCONTINUANCES:Kodak Ferro-type Polish : 8 OzKodak Waxing Solution : 4 Oz

The Chemical Preparations Division announce the discontinuance of two products, namely Kodak Ferro-type Polish : 8 Oz size, and Kodak Waxing Solution : 4 Oz; this removes both these products from our Production Lists. The sales of these two lines have dwindled to virtually nothing in the last few years and production is no longer economical.

Kodak Glazing Solution

This department announces the discontinuance of the 8 Oz size Kodak Glazing Solution. The 4 Oz pack of this product now becomes the standard amateur product.

No stock is held now but there is on the way to certain branches the last of the 8 Oz size.
