KODACOLOR-X FILM now ASA 80

New independent methods used in determining speed ratings for colour negative films have increased the speed ratings of Kodacolor-X Film by 1/3rd stop. It is emphasized that there is no change in the film or emulsion.

Films affected are Kodacolor-X Film, in 126 size cartridges for Kodak Instamatic Cameras, CX 127, 620, 120 roll film and CX 135, 12 and 20 exposure magazines. People with non-adjustable cameras should not be concerned about the higher speed rating since the wide latitude of the film will take care of the exposure variation.

The new speed may be quoted immediately even though film cartons are marked with the lower speed. The new rating has been included in the new Kodak Film Price Card.
